Explore NB Travel Incentive Program – Summer 2021



The Explore NB Travel Incentive Program Phase 3 encourages New Brunswick residents to travel and spend in New Brunswick between May 27, 2021 – October 31, 2021

The incentive program permits individuals to claim up to \$1,000 of eligible expenses for a **maximum refund** of 20% (\$200). Receipts will be considered for eligible accommodations, food and drinks, activities and travel (please see the Eligible and Ineligible Expenditures table)
